Newsworthy

3/9/09: Governor David A. Paterson announced additional transportation projects eligible for funding through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), which will make much-needed improvements to highways and bridges owned by local governments and not the State.

3/12/09: Speaker Silver discussed the Assembly's proposed overhaul of state technology uses. Silver stated that this budget initiative would reduce the State's reliance on private contractors and would change the IT procurement process. He hopes to see this enacted in the budget.

3/24/09: Governor David A. Paterson today announced the historic appointment of Justice Luis A. Gonzalez to serve as Presiding Justice of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court for the First Judicial Department. Justice Gonzalez, who is the first Latino to be appointed to this position, has been an Associate Justice on the Appellate Division for the last 7 years.

3/27/09: The US Department of Health and Human Services has released \$19.4 million to expand service offered at community health centers in New York. The money comes from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

4/2/09: Governor Paterson announced the award of more than \$81 million in federal funding to transportation projects throughout all regions of New York. These funds cover projects not eligible for traditional federal transportation funding like bike paths and historic preservation. A total of 59 projects will be funded through the Transportation Enhancement Program (TEP), with some additional funds allocated through the (ARRA).
