6/3/10: The New York State Senate confirmed 16 appointees to several key boards today, including members to the Ogdensburg Bridge & Port Authority, the Administrative Review Board for Professional Medical Conduct, the Small Business Advisory Board, the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York, the City University Construction Fund, the State Insurance Fund, etc.

6/4/10: The State Department of Health (DOH) today released a Request for Proposal for a contractor to design, develop and operate a new automated system to process Medicaid claims that would replace the current Medicaid Management Information System. The procurement will result in an eight-year contract. The first three years will be devoted to design, development and implementation of the new system.

6/14/10: The New York State Summit on Rail Transportation (Summit) was held today. The Summit brought together more than two hundred public and private stakeholders in New York's rail industry to collaboratively identify and maximize New York's resources in an effort to solidify it as the premier location for rail manufacturing and servicing in the country.

6/18/10: A bill creating the Excelsior Jobs program, the centerpiece of the Governor's job-creation agenda, was sent to the Legislature today. The Excelsior Jobs Program will replace the Empire Zones program and will provide tax credits to targeted industries, implement stringent accountability standards and cap program spending to ensure prudent use of taxpayer dollars.

6/30/10: The State Senate and Assembly gave final approval to Senator Onorato's legislation (S5847F/A8237D) that cracks down on the practice of employee misclassification in the construction industry and will help to prevent the siphoning off of tens of millions of dollars in state tax revenue each year into New York's underground economy.
