



## Newsworthy

**6/30/09:** Gov. Paterson today announced the certification of an additional \$95.3 million for transportation projects through the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.

**7/1/09:** The State of New York filed a request with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that they grant a waiver of its 700 MHz public safety early deployment rules to enable the construction and operation of a 700 MHz interoperable public safety broadband network.

**7/2/09:** Gov. Paterson and the New York State CIO/OFT Statewide Interoperability Program Office (SIPO) hosted the first New York State Public Safety Interoperability Symposium in Albany, New York. The goal of the Symposium was to help state and local policymakers improve state interoperability governance structures that oversee public safety communications interoperability planning and implementation.

**7/8/09:** Gov. Paterson announced the appointments of Marty Mack to serve as Deputy Secretary for Appointments, Cathy Calhoun to serve as Deputy Secretary for Intergovernmental Affairs and Thomas Congdon to serve as Deputy Secretary for Energy.

**7/9/09:** Gov. Paterson announced that he has appointed a stimulus oversight panel to further his commitment to ensuring that federal economic recovery funds are utilized with transparency and accountability. The panel will be headed by the State Inspector General Justice Joseph Fisch, and will include the State's Medicaid Inspector General James Sheehan, the Inspector General of the Metropolitan Transportation Authority Barry Kluger and State Division of Human Rights Commissioner Galen Kirkland.

**7/9/09:** Senator Espada rejoins the Democratic Conference. Sen. Skelos says he is challenging Espada to insist on the reforms as he said he would. It is in the best interest of everyone especially the constituents.
