5/6/10: The New York State Department of Labor has received a \$1.1 million grant from the U.S. Department of Labor to estimate how many green jobs there are and to identify new, emerging and enhanced skills needed for green jobs.

5/18/10: The NYS CIO/OFT hosted the Technology Sector Minority and Woman Owned Business Enterprise (MWBE) Champions Forum. During the event, Dr. Melodie Mayberry-Stewart, New York State Chief Information Officer and Director of the Office for Technology, recognized eleven global IT Corporate MWBE Champions who are on track to achieve IT supplier diversity goals for 2010 in New York State technology procurements. They included: CMA, Dell, EMC2, Hewlett Packard, IBM, Microsoft, nFrastructure Technologies, Oracle, Tandberg, Unisys, and Xerox.

5/20/10: New York State's economy added 31,500 private sector jobs (+0.4%) on a seasonally adjusted basis in April 2010, the State Labor Department reported today. This was the state's fourth straight monthly jobs increase.

5/21/10: The Empire State Stem Cell Board today voted to award \$30.5 million in State funding to support biomedical research infrastructure and stem cell research training in New York State. The investment underscores New York's commitment to build a strong biomedical industry and to create unique training opportunities for stem cell investigators within the State.

5/27/10: NYSDOT Acting Commissioner Stanley Gee today announced that New York State has received the first allocation of funds from a total of \$151 million in grants awarded to New York State for high-speed and intercity passenger rail projects through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act from the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA).
