12/04/09: Governor David A. Paterson today announced that New York will receive at least \$31 billion in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds, part of \$420 billion that will be appropriated to states and other recipients over the length of the federal stimulus program. New York will receive \$3 billion for infrastructure projects, including \$2.4 billion for transportation and about \$571 million for clean water, drinking water and wastewater projects.

12/08/09: State Health Commissioner Richard F. Daines, M.D., announced today that the Department of Health will use a three-year federal grant to improve communication between health care providers and DOH on newborn screening information.

12/11/09: New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) Acting Commissioner Stanley Gee today announced the selection of the projects recommended for federal funding to purchase 188 accessible buses to support agencies that transport elderly individuals and individuals with disabilities. The Department, which administers the program on behalf of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), has submitted a total of 88 grant recommendations for review. Final approval of these grant recommendations is expected in early Spring, 2010.

12/15/09: Governor David A. Paterson today accepted the final 2009 State Energy Plan from the New York State Energy Planning Board. The Energy Plan provides a comprehensive blueprint for New York to continue to transition to a clean energy economy over a 10-year planning horizon, and is the first State energy plan since 2002. The transition to a clean energy economy is a core component of Governor Paterson's New Economy Jobs Plan, and is expected to create tens of thousands of jobs in New York.
