4/5/10: Governor David A. Paterson announced today that the State, local governments, universities, businesses, and not-for profits submitted 49 federal broadband stimulus grant requests totaling approximately \$600 million under the NTIA's Broadband Technology Opportunity Program (BTOP). Grants will ensure broadband service is universally available in unserved and underserved, urban and rural communities to bridge the digital divide, increase digital literacy, and spur economic development.

4/8/10: Today, U.S. Senator Charles E. Schumer and New York State Department of Labor Commissioner Colleen C. Gardner urged New York City area businesses to take advantage of his "Hire Now Tax Cut" proposal that now provides businesses that hire unemployed workers a critical tax break. Under the plan, businesses can now avoid paying the employer's share of Social Security taxes on that worker for the duration of 2010.

4/28/10: Governor David A. Paterson was joined today by business leaders and labor representatives to highlight the importance of two critical economic development programs due to expire on May 15. He urged the Legislature to pass reform measures to the Power For Jobs and Energy Cost Savings Benefit programs, both administered by the New York Power Authority (NYPA), to stabilize existing businesses and institutions, promote economic growth and create jobs for New Yorkers.

4/30/10: The 2010 New York State CIO Academy was held in Albany on April 28-29. "The 2010 CIO Academy was a wonderful training and networking opportunity for our agency and local CIOs who are continuously striving to increase efficiencies and drive down operating costs through innovative uses of technology," said Dr. Mayberry-Stewart, New York State Chief Information Officer, Director of the Office for Technology, and Chair of the CIO Academy Advisory Board.
